Dear Madam,

Greetings from the Consulate General of India, Dubai.

The Indian School, Ajman (CBSE affiliation No. 6630021 and school no. is 90206) has been functioning from the premises located in Al Jurf -2, Ajman since 1988. Last year, on the basis of inspections conducted by the local authorities, the Ministry of Education, UAE (MoE) has directed the school management to shift the school to some other premises on the grounds that the existing building was incompatible with the local standards.

The request by the school authorities to allow them to construct a new building on the existing plot by partly demolishing the existing structure was not acceded to by the MoE, UAE. The MoE UAE has given the school an ultimatum to shift to new safer and compatible premises before the academic year 2020-2021.

The school management identified a new plot and has constructed a new building which is much bigger, better equipped safer and more compatible to the standards of the local authorities as compared to the existing school building. The new plot is in the name of an Emirati national who will be acting as a local sponsor of the school.

The school management intends to shift the school lock, stock and barrel to the new premises and start the academic year 2020 -2021 from the new premises.

However, the existing local sponsor of the school is not permitting the school management to use the name "Indian School, Ajman" at the new premises. As per the local laws the school will not be in a position to use the old name without the consent of the old local sponsor.


In view of the above, the school management has registered a new name "Global Indian School" with the local authorities and have already obtained Commercial and Professional license from the local authorities. The actual owners of the Indian School, Ajman have also given their no objection to transfer all the infrastructure, equipments, movable assets to Global Indian School. They have also given their no objection in transferring the CBSE affiliation of Indian School, Ajman to Global Indian School, Ajman and have also undertaken not to use the above mentioned affiliation no. at the old premises.

The students, teachers, infrastructure of the existing Indian School, Ajman will be shifted to Global Indian School, Ajman. It is therefore, requested that the affiliation number 6630021 belonging to Indian School, Ajman may be transferred to Global Indian School, Ajman for the academic year 2020-2021.

The affidavit given by the partner of the Indian School, Ajman giving their no objection is enclosed.



Therefore, the school should change all the records and letter heads accordingly. All concerned are requested to note above change in school name accordingly.


The above approval will be subjected to following conditions:-
